### **UNM, Mind Network Reach Agreement**

The Mind Research Network and the University of New Mexico have signed an agreement to improve cooperative research and development of neuroscience technology.

Mind Research Network President John Rasure says the agreement will help in commercializing diagnostic technology on brain disease and mental illness.

UNM President David Schmidly says the agreement will give faculty who work with the mind network access to state-of-the-art equipment that will benefit both institutions.

### **Farmington Plans For Development Grants**

FARMINGTON — Farmington plans to spend \$2.2 million in federal funds over the next five years for housing for recovering drug addicts, a day care center, low-income housing, emergency rental assistance and other programs.

City councilors decided last week how the city would spend federal Community Development Block grants. It will receive almost \$431,000 annually through the next five years.

Community Development Department associate planner Jay Peterman says Farmington received \$2.3 million in community development funds in the past five years.
