What meals are included with a conference registration?

No. Although having dealt with the data before may be helpful, it is not a necessity. The course is intended to teach all those interested in fMRI imaging whether novices or experts.

I only want to come to the conference for a day, is there a daily fee?

No. You must pay the full registration fee to attend any of the sessions.

How many people will be at the conference?

Although final numbers are not yet confirmed, we plan to host between thirty and forty attendees.

If we do not attend the social outing will we get a price break on registration fees?

No, there is no cost for the social outing in our course registration fee. Attendance is optional; however, it is a great networking opportunity and a chance to visit with the instructors as well as meet the other course attendees who are working in the area of fMRI. The instructors treat all attendees to one drink and appetizers at the social outing.

If I sign up but cannot attend, what is the cancellation policy?

If notice of cancellation is provided more than 30 days prior to the first day of the course, refunds may be given at the instructors' discretion. If cancellation is provided within 30 days of the first day of the course a refund will not be given but the tuition can be applied to a future course.

What is the dress code?

There is no specific dress code but business casual attire is encouraged.

What should I bring to the conference?

All you need to bring is a laptop. We will provide all other materials needed: including food, transportation, a USB, and a binder of all course materials.

Will we have any free time?

The conference begins promptly at 8:00am and gets out at 6:00pm. The first night we encourage our guests to attend a social outing at 7:00pm after this. Guests will have the evenings free.

What can we do during our free time?

Albuquerque has a number of options available.
