I only want to come to the conference for a day, is there a daily fee?

No, you must pay the full registration fee to attend any of the sessions.

How many people will be at the conference?

Although final numbers have not yet been confirmed, we plan to host between 20 to 30 attendees.

Do I need to have worked with fMRI data before attending?

No, although having dealt with the data before may be helpful, it is not a necessity. The course is intended to teach all those interested in fMRI imaging whether novices or experts.

I have registered and paid my fee but now unable to attend. What is your cancellation policy?

If notice of cancellation is provided more than 30 days prior to the first day of the course, refunds may be given at the instructors' discretion. If cancellation is provided within 30 days of the first day of the course, a refund will not be given but the tuition can be applied to a future course.

What should I bring to the conference?

All you need to bring is a laptop. We will provide all other materials needed including food, transportation, a USB, and a binder of all course materials.

What is the dress code?

There is no specific dress code but business casual attire is encouraged.

We have a negotiated discounted rate with the Sheraton Albuquerque Airport Hotel of \$102.00. To reserve a discounted room, please book online or call the number above and ask for the SET Account Number 228069. The hotel is 3.6 miles/9 minutes away from MRN.

Is transportation to and from the conference included, or do I need to rent a car?

It is not necessary to rent a car. MRN and Sheraton will work together to transport all participants to and from the conference each morning/evening; transportation is only provided by Sheraton. Transportation to the social outing will be included. Participants staying at other locations are fully responsible for their own transportation. Uber and Lyft are available in Albuquerque and can be an economical option.

What meals are included with a conference registration?

Registration includes a light continental breakfast, lunch, snacks and coffee throughout the day. Dinner is not included. On the first night of the conference, we will provide all attendees with the option to attend a social outing that includes appetizers and drinks (August 3).

Are vegetarian, gluten-free, or vegan meals available?

Yes, specialty meals are available. However, we ask those with dietary restrictions to let us know at least a week before the conference begins (July 27), to arrange with the caterer.
